ATTENTION – HORSE UNITS

In accordance with state law, we will require a current Coggins Test certificate for each horse, prior to you being admitted to the parade line up.

Upon arriving at the grounds the morning of the parade, all incoming horse units will be diverted to a separate area for review of the Coggins Test documents. After the records are reviewed and the horses are observed, you will be allowed to proceed to the horse unloading area at the West side of the infield.

Please bring your ORIGINAL test report AND a legible photocopy to leave with us for our files. As you know, we are required to keep these on file for at lease two years. The original Certificate of Veterinary Inspection Health Paper is also required, plus a copy to retain for the inspector's files.

The Coggins Test is good for 1 year for Wisconsin horses. Out of state horse entries need to check with their veterinarian and obtain an intra-state form. Health papers need to be certified not more than 30 days prior to the event.

Unfortunately, if you fail to bring your Coggins Test certificate, WE WILL NEED TO TURN YOU AWAY AT THE PARADE GROUNDS. Thank you for your assistance in meeting this requirement and we look forward to seeing you in the parade.
